

RHODE ISLAND – DMV REQUIREMENTS

The Rhode Island Rider Education Program **does** recognize other Rider Education Programs as long as they use the Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course curriculum. Rhode Island residents who take and pass an MSF certified motorcycle safety course in a different state are eligible to receive their Rhode Island motorcycle license/endorsement as long as they complete the following prior to visiting a local branch of the DMV.

Candidates who have successfully completed their MSF training must visit the Knight Campus of the Community College of Rhode Island and bring the following documents:

1. Copy of your Rhode Island Motorcycle Learners Permit or License
2. Copy of your Motorcycle Safety Foundation Completion Card and/or Certificate
3. Copy of your Rider Course Skills Evaluation and Knowledge Test on the schools letterhead.
